

MARCHING BAND UNIFORM INFORMATION

1. **Pay Uniform Maintenance Fee: \$25.00** (if not paid for with Band Registration Fees). When you return your cleaned uniform at the end of the Marching Band Season, you will receive a \$10.00 credit to your student's account.
2. **Buy Gloves: \$3.00/pair** We suggest buying 2 pairs (that way you will have one spare clean pair while one pair is being used).
3. **Order and Pay for Marching Shoes: \$35/pair** We use black DRILLMASTER shoes. If you know your normal shoe size, you can order that size and it should fit the same. Once shoes are ordered, it takes approximately 2 weeks to receive them. Usually they are distributed at either a Tuesday evening or Saturday afternoon rehearsal late in September.
4. **Schedule Uniform fitting date:** Marching Band uniform fittings take place during Band Camp. You will need to sign up on the first day of Band Camp for a particular date and time to be fitted. Meet in the lobby of Little Theatre for your fitting.

Other things to know about the Marching Band Uniform:

1. Under the uniform, you are responsible for wearing a black t-shirt or tank top and black shorts (which you provide).
2. Always wear black socks (which you provide).
3. Your uniform will be placed in a bag with your name on a color-coded tag in a see-through pocket on the bag (Percussion/Pit/Drumline = green, Sax = yellow, Brass = Blue, Low Brass = White, Flute = Purple, and Clarinet = Orange).
4. Once you are given your uniform, it is your responsibility to keep it clean and maintained. You can wash your jacket and pants in the washing machine in warm to cold setting with a "Color Catcher" sheet (found at Safeway, Wal-Mart, Target, etc.) and dry it in the dryer on Permanent Press setting. Take it out of the dryer before it stops and there will be no wrinkles. If you have any problems with the uniforms or its function, please let the uniform coordinator know right away. 5. Keep your marching shoes clean and polished.
